From a methodological point of view, this conference seeks to explore economic and econometric techniques to study financial literacy issues. We especially welcome research that applies impact evaluation identification strategies (e.g. difference-in-differences, instrumental variables, randomized controlled trials (RCT)) or structural equation models.
